Bert Uytley (1948)

is an artist who specializes in digital art. He concentrates on pictures that look like photos but in fact it are carefully digitally composed pictures of daily life scenes. Sometimes straightforward, sometimes they evoke questions. He leaves the interpretation to the viewer. Because the pictures have graphic accents he likes to call them photo graphics. He took education in art, photography and many other worldly affairs, however he sees himself as autodidact.

"My digital images are mostly based on feelings like irritation, domination, frustration, amazement and fear. During the creative process a view of a situation arises as if it were a photo. A snapshot. The picture is very structured with many horizontals and verticals, concentrated on the subject with few distracting elements. The final result is a polished image in which the emotion is controlled and sometimes hard to spot. The emotion has been subordinated to the ratio."
